Search strategy:

We will assess the frequency of the personality disorders in individuals with functional seizures. The search strategy will include the following terms:

The initial search was perfomed on PubMed and other sources (Ovid MEDLINE, PsycINFO). "Functional seizures" and their synonyms (e.g. psychogenic non epileptic seizures) was searched in a combination with a set of key words, where the search structure was as follows: ("functional seizure*" OR "keyword.1" OR keyword.2" OR...) AND ("personality disorders" OR "keyword.3" OR keyword.4"). The keywords.1 and keyoword.2 were "functional seizures"- synonymous, while "keyword.3" OR keyword.4" were "personality disorders"-synonymous.

Only full text and English text articles were retained, and editorials, letters, review and metaanalysis were excluded.

We have already made our list of potential articles, but we have not started to assess each article with the exclusion-inclusion criteria.
